He married MARIA HOLLAND 1820 in Smith Co, TN. She was born December 10, 1801 in Virginia, and died January 03, 1880 in Field Township, Jefferson Co, IL.

Notes for REV. ELIJAH WIMBERLY:

Elijah Wimberly left Smith County TN in 1830 and moved to Jefferson County, IL. He brought his wife, Maria, his five children, Evaline, Thomas, Louisa, Lanie, Lucy and two sisters, Milly and Betsey. According to later sources, there were 13 children born but only 11 can be accounted for as of 11/1998.

Elijah's father, Lewis, stipulated in his will that if Elijah would stay home and take care of his mother and his younger brothers and sisters, then he would inherit the plantation upon the death of his mother. In 1830, Elijah sold 300 acres of land in Smith County, TN to Jacob Uhles. (source: Katie Nola). This would indicate Elijah's mother (Polly or Mary) had died and he was released from his obligation to take care of his mother. Elijah immediately packed up his belongings and left for Jefferson County, IL.

WIMBERLY, Rev. Elijah Wimberly was born in the State of NC, 14 November 1800; was carried by his parents, in early life, to Jefferson Co., ILL in 1829. In 1830 he was born of the Spirit and licensed to exhort in the Methodist Church, and in that capacity he continued until 10 September 1876, when having served his generation he fell asleep. This grand old patriarch of Israel was one of nature's noblemen... (eulogy) "Uncle Lige" as he was called was educated in the school of pioneer Methodism. He leaves a wife and 7 children. - MC (27 Sept 1876)

He was carried by his parents in early life from Pendleton District of South Carolina to Sumner Co (now Smith Co) TN in Abt 1801 and he moved to Jefferson County, IL in 1830. Rev. Elijah was born in South Carolina, not North Carolina.

Elijah Wimberly started his own church between Dix, IL and Texico, IL. The church was known as Jordan Chapel Methodist Church. Elijah donated part of his farmland to the church and the cemetery is still standing.

Thomas Jefferson Wimberly and his wife lived in poverty in their later life. After Thomas Jefferson Wimberly died, his widow lived with friends and finally lived with her son, Charles Franklin Wimberly, the peacher, until her death. There were attempts to obtain a soldier's pension based on James H. Wimberly's (their oldest son) Civil War illness but the pension was denied because James did not report on sick call when he became ill with hepatitis.

Thomas Jefferson Wimberly and his wife, Martha (White) Wimberly, were Charter Members of the Union Chapel Church east of Texico, IL.

He was in the war with Mexico in 1846, in Company H, Third Illinois Volunteer Infantry. He was married, April 2, 1848, to Miss Julia A., daughter of Elijah Wimberly, of Tennessee, since of Jefferson County, IL. Lewis (Louis) W. Wimberly died at the residence of his son-in-law, Neil McLean, at Independence, (CA) on the 7th of September, 1895, and was buried in the Masonic Cemetery last Sunday. The deceased had lived at Keeler, CA for a number of years and had many warm friends in the southern end of the valley. He had been ailing for a long time, and his death was not unexpected.

The cemetery borders Clay ST from Pavilion ST to the creek and runs eastward approximately two blocks. It is a neatly fenced cemetery with good clean grounds maintained by a local cemetery district. It is located across the street from the Inyo County High School and the Church of Jesus Christ of the Latter Day Saints. This cemetery was inventoried on July 20 and 21st of 1965 by Sherman Lee Pompey and records compared with those of Mr. Ray Lusher, Veteran's Service Officer and a member of the Cemetery District of Independence.

Louis Wimberly was 5' 11" in height and was born in Illinois. His place of residence was Keeler, CA. He was a farmer in August, 1888 at the age of 56 and he lived in Lone Pine, CA

In 1860, he was a resident of Mud Springs, El Dorado County, California. He was 27 years old. His occupation was a miner with real estate value of \$800.

In the 1875 State Census of Nevada, this is a listing for Louis W. Wimberly, 42 years of age, Annie Wimberly, 13 years of age (his daughter); and Robert L. Wimberly, 11 years of age (his son). The Washoe County Newspaper Index has an entry for Louis W. Wimberly as a member of the Washoe County Grand Jury, Nevada State Journal, January 6, 1876, 3:3, and has one listing for Robert, Roll of Honor, Huffaker School, and one for March 26, 1876, 3:3. All were living at Huffaker. In the 1880 Census, there is a listing for Robert Wimberly and Annie L. Wimberly.

Notes for ELIZABETH FIELDS:

Elizabeth Fields died in about 1870 and the cause of her death was Indians. Indians at that time in California were small tribes and had a habit of raiding cabins while the man of the house was away. If Louis was away at work (he was a miner) and Laura and Robert were at school. then it could have been Elizabeth was alone in the cabin when it was raided by a small tribe of Indians. The death of Elizabeth was confirmed by Neil McLean and

Aunt Lucille in 1979. Aunt Lucille stated that her mothers' parents (Elizabeth Fields) died when her mother (Laura) was 8 or 9 years of age.

Bennett Franklin Wimberly, farmer, PO Dix, was born in this county (Jefferson) on June 25, 1843; is the son of Elijah and Maria (Hollin) Wimberly. She was a native of Virginia, he of Tennessee. They came to this county at an early date, and died here. They were the parents of thirteen children, of whom four sons and two daughters are still living. Our subject's early life was spent in tilling the soil, and with but little advantage for a school education. When reaching his majority, he embarked in life for himself, and has through his own exertions been very successful. Most of his life he has been engaged in farming, but for eighteen months was in the mercantile business at Rome. He now, however, is actively engaged in making his present farm of 160 acres a complete success. In 1865, he was married to Miss Sally Walls. She was born in Marion County, IL, daughter of Henry Walls. Five children are the result of this union, viz., Alonzo, Emma, Robert, Clarence and Cora. In politics, his views coincide with those of the Democrat party.

Luella Wimberly died when she either committed suicide or accidently hung herself from an apple tree in the orchard of her father, Thomas Harvey Wimberly. There are unconfirmed reports she had been sexually assaulted by her brother, Walter, and was pregnant. The shame was so great because her parents were so religious (her great-grandfather Elijah was a minister) that certain members of the family believe Luella decided the best way out of the embarrassment was to end her life.

The death could also be an accident. No inquest was every held that the editor knows about.

There is also a possibility that Walter killed Luella because she was pregnant. Her brother, Wallace, and her sister, Maude, found her hanging in the tree but could not remember any other details. Wallace was never interviewed by this reporter on the matter up to his death in 1967 because no one in the family ever talked about the incident. The secret was revealed in 1985 when the reporter, Thomas Wimberly, interviewed the daughter of Maude, Ila Mae (Whitlock) Hughes.

Charles Franklin Wimberly was involved in somewhat of a scandal while he attended Ewing College in Ewing, IL. In 1888 and 1889, Charles was involved in a "fame-up" that almost destroyed his career as a minister. Charles was living at the home of a prominent citizen of Ewing. He allegedly got involved sexually with the cook at the house through the son of the owner of the house. When the cook got pregnant and the grown son disappeared, the cook placed the blame on Charles and had him arrested. Charles married the girl and promptly left her. He did, however, pay support for many years after for the boy that was born.

In 1904, probably after the story about his "problem" became known at the church in Excelsior Springs, MO, where he was pastor, he asked the former "acting president" of Ewing College at the time of his "problem", John Richeson, to write a "character reference" letter for him. It probably did little to save his ministry for it was two years, in 1906, before he obtained another church. His next church was located at Louisville, Kentucky.

No one in Charles Franklin Wimberly's family knew about the letter until the early 1970's when the following letter was discovered in some of Charles' papers. Everyone in his family was shocked and surprised that

something as scandalous as what happened could be kept a secret for so many years without someone in the family knowing about it.

The young lady referred to in this story, Cordelia Lansford, was left by herself to raise the boy (Charles M. Wimberly) who was born from this unfortunate situation. Charles was a coal miner and lived in Marion, IL. He married Nettie Copher and they had four fine children. Charles died young, however, probably from "Black Lung" disease, on November 11, 1938 at the age of 47.

Notes for NEIL MCLEAN:

In the 1880's Keeler, CA was the southern terminus of the C&C Railroad. The primary property in that area at that time was the Cerro-Gordo Gold Mine which is currently owned by Jody Stewart.

I have copies of voting records back as far as 1878 listing Neil McLean, Lewis W. Wimberly, and Robert Lee Wimberly as residents of Keeler, CA. Sometime in the late 1880's, Neil McLean met Annie Laura Wimberly and in March, 1891, they were married at the Inyo County seat in Independence, CA. From that union were born four children all in the 1890's.

By 1900, Neil had been a freighter, or as known then a teamster, for about 20 years. Freighting in those days was an industry much like today only the technology was different. Huge quantities of freight were hauled south over the rails thru Owens Valley then unloaded at Keeler. Gold ore from the Cerro-Gordo Gold mine would be loaded on the then empty cars and hauled north. The freight would be re-loaded onto huge freight wagons pulled by 20 and 30 horses or mules. They would literally spread out across the desert floor.

In November, 1900 Neil wandered across the Nevada State line into what was to be Tonopah, NV and met a fella by the name of Jim Butler. Neil and Jim created what was probably the first non-mining contract in town. Jim hired Neil to deliver 100 horses. Neil delivered those critters in early 1901.

Over the years, Neil, the Scotsman, developed a working relationship with an Irishman named John McSweeney. On January 2, 1904, the contracting firm of McLean and McSweeney won the bid for most of the labor to lay the track for the first railroad to Tonopah, NV. That task was completed in May, 1904.

The four children born from that marriage in 1891 (Evelyn, Francis, Winsor, and Marguerite) attended school in Tonopah from late 1905 until sometime in 1912. Of the three girls, two became school teachers and the oldest, Francis, became one of the first female doctors licensed in the State of California. Neil and Laura named their only son after the guy that married them, Winsor.

Between 1905 and 1911, Neil was the primary contractor for the railroads built to Silver Peak (1906), Goldfield (1905), and the B&G (Bullfrog and Goldfield Railroad) was completed in 1907 to Rhyolite, CA. In 1911, Neill took 400 men from the Tonopah and Goldfield, NV area to Laws (near Bishop) for a sixty-day project. He completed the contract but the tracks were never laid for what was suppose to be an electric railway.

In late 1912, Laura decided she had had enough of Tonopah, NV and insisted on moving to the big city to the south, Los Angeles. Although the family moved to Los Angeles, CA, Neil continued to have a hand in the operation of McLean and McSweeney until his death in 1922. Jim Butler died in 1923.

On July 6, 1991, the McLean family will be holding a 100 year family reunion at the Lions Club in Tonopah, NV.

Justifiable Homicide

Miss Bertha Bennett Shoots Robert L. Wimberly in Self Defense.

Robert L. Wimberly, a well known miner of Downieville, was shot and instantly killed, on Friday afternoon of last week, Aug. 25th, by his sister-in-law, Miss Bertha Bennett, under circumstances, according to her statements, which caused the authorities to refuse to place her under arrest, and the coroner's jury later to fully exonerate her as a case of justifiable homicide. All the principals in the deplorable affairs are well known in Downieville, and nothing caused such a profound sensation in this peaceful and orderly community as the news of the tragedy when circulated like wild fire early Friday evening.

County Coroner McDonald and County Physician Duty immediately repaired to the scene on the old Jenkin's

ranch on the South Fork of the North Yuba. Meanwhile Miss Bennett and her sister, the wife of the deceased, started for Downieville, Miss Bennett with the purpose to give herself up to Sheriff McGregor. A statement of the facts having been given District Attorney Redding, the ladies, on his suggestion as well as that of Sheriff McGregor, returned to the ranch to await the verdict of the coroner's jury. Miss Bennett's home is in Grants Pass, Oregon, in which she and her sister were born. Since Mrs. Wimberly's residence in Downieville, Miss Bennett has occasionally spent her summer vacation here.

It seems that Robert Wimberly had become infatuated with her and she wisely chose to foreshorten her present vacation and return to Oregon the latter part of last week. According to her testimony to the coroner's panel last Saturday she was engaged the day before in assisting her sister about the house in domestic duties, and had gone to the spring some distance from the house for a bucket of water, when Wimberly appeared and at the point of a pistol compelled her to accompany him to a distant part of the field on the hillside, beyond a rise out of view of the house. He overcome her protests by threatening her. Just before reaching the spot she momentarily lost consciousness and on coming to, found Wimberly attempting to rape her person. Her resistance was met with threats of death to herself and himself, she alleged. Her pleas and appeals to his mercy, she stated, were also unavailing. He then laid the pistol on the ground but within her reach. Taking it up, she declared, she threatened to shoot if he did not desist. He attempted to take the weapon from her, whereupon she pulled the trigger. The bullet entered his head at the left ear and penetrated his brain. Death was instantaneous. Miss Bennett went to the house and told her sister what had happened and the two women went to the place of the struggle. Then they started for town after sending Jim Alexander to notify the authorities.

Miss Bennett's appearance and that of Wimberly's body corroborated her story and, as stated above, the authorities decided not to place her under arrest.

Miss Bennett's testimony at the coroner's inquest was in accordance with the main facts as related above, and the jury promptly returned a verdict of justifiable homicide. She had shot, according to her testimony, to save her life and honor.

Funeral services were held over the deceased in the Methodist Church on Sunday afternoon. Rev. L. P. Walker preaching an appropriate sermon and extending the sympathies of the community to the bereaved widow and children. The attendance at the services were large. Interment of the remains took place in the Downieville cemetery.

Wimberly was a native of Placerville, Eldorado County, Cal, and at the time of his tragic demise was nearly 42 years old. He had been a resident of Downieville 12 years, and for some time interested with Fred Bosch, Jr., in a group of mines in the Gold Valley ridge country. The property or its management, caused a disagreement between the partners and their affairs were carried into court. The property was sold by order of the Court last Monday, Val Hartling being commissioner. The trouble terminating in the sale appears to have worried Wimberly and of late he had been drinking. It is known that he was under the influence of liquor the day of the tragedy. Wimberly had a wide circle of acquaintances and was held in high esteem by his friends, being regarded by them as a hard working and honest miner.

Mrs. Wimberly's testimony was to the effect that the deceased, her husband, had some weeks ago shown an infatuation with her sister, and also laterly had drank very heavily.

Miss Bennett, who is 18 years old was a favorite here socially, and all deplore the unfortunate affair. Her return to Oregon has been postponed for the present.

The family lived at Candelaria for about 4 years (1900-1904). Laura Wimberly must have had some discussions with her niece, Vivian Wimberly."

"According to Aunt Lucille, Vivian Wimberly was a very bright girl who had a mining degree from Nevada University. She moved to New York in about 1928 where she married a "well to do doctor" Wouldn't it be neat if could find out if she had any kids and we could make contact with them."

"Vivian Wimberly would have been about 25 or 26 when she was Treasurer of the mining company. In those days women at that age didn't get a job like that unless you had a lot on the ball,"

Leuty had sold the farm to Bert Green, who died, and Wallace's father, Thomas Harvey, purchased the land (60 Acres) and house at an estate auction on March 25, 1915 for the sum of \$2,000. Thomas Harvey then sold the land to Wallace on March 27, 1915 at exactly the same price, \$2,000.

Alice became pregnant with their only child, John Thomas Wimberly, in March of 1915, about the same time Wallace purchased the Bert Green property.

The 1880's were fraught with memories, especially of the older generation, of the terrible chinchbug year of 1881 - a famine spread upon the land and the whole decade reflected the effects of this desolate time. But - some good came from all this notably, our vice president, Mrs. Alice Byars Wimberley, born at the upper edge of the county, both Marion and Jefferson Counties could lay claim to her accomplishments.

When Alice was an energetic young girl she carved a reputation for herself in one of those long-ago and now forgotten millinery stores. This store was located on the mains treet in Kell, Illinois. Today so called hats for women are manufactured and shipped ready to sell but in the old days the hats were really hats and although the milliner had no blueprint to guide her she did have a sort of foundation made of wire. She also had hundreds of yards of horsehair braids, and ribbons and laces, along with artificial flowers and fruits of all descriptions. The rest was up to her imagination and Alice really did have a wonderul imagination - and so did a boy named Wallace. When he grew too interested she closed her shop and flew to Texas. He followed. Wedding bells rang

out at her Uncle Worth's, Result one fine boy named Tom. (John Thomas Wimberly)

Ewing College History

Many years ago, there were several colleges and seminaries across Southern Illinois. The one at Ewing was the largest and considered the most prominent. It dates to April 15, 1867, when Dr. John M. Washburn, an itinerant Baptist preacher, opened a high school in the Frizzell Prairie Baptist Church. Eventually, the high school became a college and was moved to the campus in Ewing in 1874. The campus once had seven buildings.

They included, Willard Hall, known as "The Beacon Light Throughout All Egypt," which was demolished in 1951 or 1952. The campus also had a Carnegie Library.

The college boasted the largest livery stable in Southern Illinois. More than 50 rigs were kept there. The last remaining building on campus in 1991 was once the boys' dormitory. Before it was a dormitory, it was used as a rolling mill and as part of the Richerson Woolen Factory, so it probably was built in the 1860's or early 1870's.

Boys paid from 25 cents to 50 cents a week to rent rooms, but they were required to carry their own firewood and do janitorial work. Girls paid higher rent - 50 cents to 75 cents a week - but they did not have to carry firewood. Kerosene lamps were provided for all students.

There were three literary societies at the college - the Pythagorean, the Logossian and the Euterpean. Sports, especially football, also were popular. Despite its august beginning, the college lost its Baptist sponsorship in 1912 and was closed in 1925.

When Mr. and Mrs. Sam Wimberly first came to Ft. Lauderdale the population numbered an impressive 300, Las Olas Blvd. was considered "far out", there were two automobiles in Davie, and the mailman persevered through rain, wind, heat and insects...in a horse and buggy.

That was our town 50 years ago. Sam Wimberly had brought his bride to Ft. Lauderdale on their honeymoon. Excitement of the big hotels and glittering tourist attractions were unhatched ideas, but the Wimberlys did manage some sightseeing - mostly in the Everglades. "We were both interested inland around here," says Wimberly, "so we spent most of our trip investigating the orange groves around Davie."

Back for Good

The Wimberlys returned to Chicago but three years later were back for good. They settled on a little farm in Davie and became a part of a growing community. "There was hardly anything here." recalls Mrs. Wimberly, "We traveled by boat to get to the beach, there weren't any roads."

In fact there was just one road through Davie - the old dike road, paved with limestone and just wide enough for one car. "Not that that make too much difference," says Wimberly, "There were only tow cars in Davie at the time - we bought the thrid one." Those old limestone roads were really hard on those Model T's, too - especially traveling slow. The secret was to get up to a good speed, about 25 miles an hour. Then it wasn't bad.

"But since there were no roads to speak of, almost everyone traveled by boat. That's the way farmers got their vegetables to the market from Davie to town.

"Or else we went by mule wagon. Took up most all day to make the 11 mile trip that way."

Whenever there was entertainment, it was a community affair," says Mrs. Wimberly. "We used to have all of our social events in the old schoo house."

When the Wimberlys moved into the "City" in 1924, Wall Street was the heart of town with a two-story hotel, a grocery store, post office and smattering of small shops surrrounding it.

Real Estate Office

Wimberly opened the first real estate office on Las Olas Blvd. "That was right before the big land boom," he recalls. "And it was around this time the Federation of Women's Club was started," added Mrs. Wimberly.

Fifty years have brought progress and prosperity to Ft. Lauderdale. They've brought happiness, success, and many friends to the Wimberlys, who now live at 1435 SE 14th ST. The golden anniversary couple are being honored today at an open house given by their daughter and son-in-law, Mr. and Mrs. Colie Chavis, 101 Holly Lane, Plantation, FL. Down from Gainesville for the celebration are the Wimberlys' son and daughter-in-law, Dr. and Mrs. Stan E. Wimberly.

Samuel and his father, William, participated in the 1911 land lottery with several others from Southern Illinois. The lottery is what brought the family to Florida.

In June, 1999, Thomas was appointed the Executive Director of the Regional Economic Development Corporation, a joint venture of the City of Marion and the Marion Chamber of Commerce. He served in that capacity for almost two years when he retired again in 2001.

Thomas also owned several small businesses during his lifetime. He was the owner of Tom-Ber Enterprises in

1968-1970, a small manufacturer of grandmother clocks. He was a partner and finally the sole owner of Westwood Village Apartments, a 20-unit apartment complex in Marion, IL. In 1992, he was laid-off from his position with the Department of Commerce and Community Affairs. He immediately started Wimberly & Associates, which did E-911 addressing and mapping for counties in Illinois.

After Mr. Wimberly was re-instated in his position with the Department of Commerce and Community Affairs in October, 1994, he offered the company to his son, Steven Wimberly, but Steven did not want the responsibility. The business was shut-down in 1997 after the completion of his contract with Pulaski County, IL

Thomas was an avid genealogist. He created the Wimberly Family Genealogy home page on the internet and organized an association of genealogist who did research on the Wimberly surname. The address for the home page was: <http://members.accessus.net/~twimberly/index.htm>.

Another hobby of Wimberly was computing and desktop computers. In 1980, he purchased a Radio Shack Model III computer for himself at Christmas. When he brought it home from the store, his wife, Kay, hit the ceiling. She wanted to know what that dumb thing could do besides flash numbers and letters on a TV screen. Thomas did not return the computer and instead, upgraded to a Model IV computer when it was introduced. After IBM introduced their brand of computers, Thomas saw the Radio Shack TRSDOS operating system was not going to be supported. He then constructed his first clone in 1988 and since then, constructed six computers of various sizes and capacities. He taught Basic Language programming at Radio Shack in Marion for one year.

Thomas constructed his first house at 201 Lake Shore Drive in Carterville, IL in 1963. It was a shell home purchased from IBC Homes (Southern Homes) of Marion, IL. The total cost of the house was about \$16,000 including the \$2,500 cost of the lot. Wimberly created about \$2,500 sweat equity in this venture. Two additions were added: a 16'x16' family room in 1966, and a 24'x24' garage in 1969. The family room cost \$800 and the garage, \$1,800. The house was sold in 1972 for \$32,500 to Prentice Smith of Homewood, IL.

In 1975, Thomas and his first wife, Sally, were divorced. Later that year, Thomas married Sylvia Kay Evett Goldstone whom he had originally met on a blind date in 1956. Thomas and Sylvia purchased the home located at 1804 Julianne Drive in Marion, IL. A friend of Thomas', Robert Wilson, had built the home in 1970. It was a perfect home to raise five children. In 1995, Thomas and Sylvia enlarged the home by building a two-car garage on the east side of the house; converting the old one-car garage into a downstairs master bedroom, and constructing a sunporch on the north side to replace the existing unprotected brick porch that overlooked the swimming pool that was installed in 1979.
